As requested, the update of all known documents / brevets/ diplomas that emanate from the HR Section of the Secretary of State's office.

N.B. The majority of documents require only the signature of the Secretary of State. This is correct Canon Law practice. The Pontiff's / Prince Bishop's signature may be applied in PDF Scan form when required.!

This is the practice of H.M.King and similarly HRH Duke of Kent as Grand Master U.G.L.E.

His Holiness Pope Francis and his predecessors never signed personally brevet honour documents. When you are advised of an appointment or promotion etc., you are required to generate documentation without prompting.

- (1) Application to be Ordained / to Join from another Church.
- (2) Declaration of Loyalty to the Holy See and its Curia.
- (3) License to Preach for one year. Cardinals for Life.
- (4) Brevet of Appointment as a Deacon, Priests etc.,
- (5) Instrument Consecrationis. Brevet.
- (6) Identity Card. This like all documents requires payment by the individual concerned as laid down in the Holy See application form issued by Cardinal Paul V Roberts as Secretary of State.
- (7) Brevet of Pontifical Nobility. / Grant of Knight Signum Fiedei.
- (8) Mandate of Elevation to Bishop / Archbishop / Cardinal. requires His Holiness' signature.





- (9) Holy See Letterheads. Approved by Secretary of State.
- (10) Letters in the name of the Pontiff or Secretary of State, to other Denominations or Nation States.
- (11) G.D.P.R. consent /acceptance form
- (12) Brevet of Doctorate of Divinity to those qualified.

N.B. Official Wax Seal tool is held by Cardinal Walsh, HOLY SEE of ANTIOCH Gentile Christian.

- 3. Contact your National / State Police to request a formal background and records check in your state, to include sexual offender registry, and have the results sent to the above address. Depending upon the state in which you reside, there may be a fee to be paid to them.
 - **NOTE:** In UK you may obtain a CRB/DBS from our own administrator. This is the source for many organizations, currently costs approximately £30 for a DBS, not including admin charge and delivers. Of the Holy See of Antioch. certificates. and Membership. ID Cards.
